



### **Rihaku – Wandering Poet**

Case Pack-6 bottles (720 ml)

Quality Grade: Junmai Ginjo (at least 40% of rice grain polished away)

Seimaibuai: 55% (45% of rice grain polished away)

Rice: Yamada Nishiki

Yeast: #9

Nihonshu-do: +3

Alcohol: 15.2%

Acidity: 1.6

Tasting Notes: Brewed carefully and slowly at low temperatures using traditional brewing techniques and Yamada Nishiki rice polished to 55%. Characterized by a well-rounded flavor with a solidness to the flavor and fragrance, and a clean finish.

Brewery Name: Rihaku Shuzo (founded in 1882).

Brewery Location: Shimane Prefecture

Toji (Master Brewer): Mitsuo Yoshioka

Notable Facts: Rihaku was named for a famous poet in China who lived from 701-762 and was famous for drinking a lot before writing. He was known to have said, "I drink a bottle, and can write 100 poems." Taste it, you'll see why.
