WINEMAKER LEANDRO AZIN

Leandro is one of Argentina's "young winemakers to watch." He
makes exceptional quality wines with a sense of place, and is at
the helm of the new terroir research and winemaking styles
coming from Mendoza.

A FRESH APPROACH TO WINEMAKING

- Vineyards: Areyna Malbec and Cabernet Sauvignon are harvested from the coolest estate vineyard blocks in Lujan de Cuyo. Areyna Torrontes is sourced from the Grand Cru terroir for Torrontes in Argentina, the high elevation desert of Cafayate, Salta.
- Harvest: Areyna grapes are picked earliest in harvest to preserve natural acidity and fresh fruit flavors. Canopy management is key to prevent over-concentration from the strong Mendoza sun.
- Winemaking: The reds spend only 3-6 months in used oak. This gives structure and complexity to the wines without imparting any oak flavor.
