VARIETAL: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon **ALCOHOL:** 13.5% **REGION:** California **SIZE:** 12/750ml

TERROIR: Mostly from the west side of Paso Robles-Willow Creek, Templeton Gap, and small amounts of a few other AVAs to add intrigue and complexity to this 100% Cabernet Sauvignon. The complexity is achieved through the blending of different geographical areas, not varietals, in this wine

HARVEST & WINEMAKING: Grapes picked ripe at 24 brix. Partially destemmed directly to tank. 48-hour cold soak-3 pump overs for 10 days, then 1-2 for the next 5.

AGING: Aged 10 months in new, one and two-year-old French oak barrels from Taransaud.

TASTING NOTES

- Plum with brick red hue. A medium-bodied Cabernet Sauvignon, soft and supple on its entry yet balanced perfectly over resolved grape and oak tannin. The mid-palate is silky with blackberry and rich, dark cherry.
- Aged in an old-world style in seasoned French Oak, the finish recalls tobacco, cedar, and the classical bordelaise pencil lead notes.
